

# Unemployment insurance cost facts every *Iowa nonprofit* should know

What do state unemployment taxes (SUTA), wage base increases and claim overpayment rates mean to your nonprofit?



**Iowa**

***These factors could mean less money for your nonprofit organization's cause.***

**\$407**

AVERAGE SUTA COST PER EMPLOYEE

In 2015, Iowa's average state unemployment tax cost per employee was about \$407.

**\$48 Million**

IMPROPER CLAIM PAYMENTS

Iowa's July 2014—June 2015 improper unemployment claim payment rate was 11.235%, equaling over \$48 million.

**\$28,300**

2016 WAGE BASE

Iowa's unemployment wage base increased from \$27,300 in 2015 to \$28,300 in 2016; therefore increasing the wages on which employers pay SUTA on.

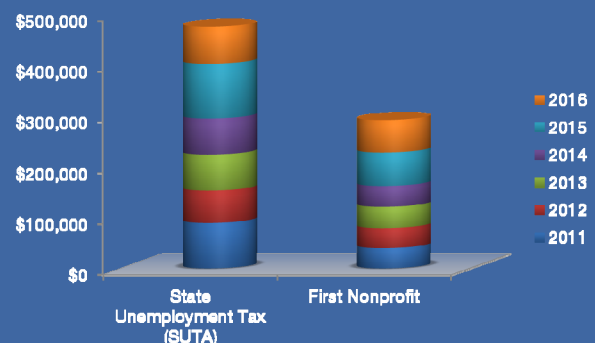
